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When You Travel:

When traveling outside of the U.S. please travel with the following documents:

- Form I-20/DS-2019 (with valid travel signature)
- Passport w/ valid visa
- Proof of Funding (GA/Scholarship Offer Letter, Personal Bank Statement)
- SEVIS I-901 Fee receipt (check status or reprint at www.fmjfee.com)
- Enrollment Verification (for F-1/J-1 students only)
- UConn Invitation Letter (for J-1 Visiting Scholars)
- EAD and employment offer letter (for F-1 students on post-completion OPT)

OPTIONAL TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- Conference registration documentation if traveling abroad for a conference.
- Documentation of family emergency if traveling due to family emergency mid-semester.

If you need to renew your F-1/J-1 visa while traveling, please start the visa renewal process as soon as possible. Visit www.usembassy.gov for more information on how to renew your F-1/J-1 visa. If renewing your visa, you may need to travel with the documents listed above, as well as a full academic transcript or study/research plan.

When You Return to the U.S.:

Keep all your original documents needed for your reentry with you at all times. Keep copies of all these documents with you or in a separate bag/luggage as well. When returning to the U.S., please make sure your passport is stamped appropriately. It should be stamped "F-1 (F/2) D/S" or "J-1 (J-2) D/S". After arriving in the U.S. please remember to print two copies (one for you, one for ISSS) of your new I-94. You can print your I-94 online at https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/request.html

If you renewed your passport or visa while you were at home, please bring copies of your new documents to the ISSS.

If You Are Denied Reentry:

Ask to speak to a supervisor and then represent your case. Ask if the inspections officer could kindly verify your status by contacting our office: **1-860-486-3855.** If you are in Canada, in addition to the above suggestions, you can seek reentry at another port of entry (Niagara Falls, Buffalo, Toronto, Montreal, etc.).
