STAYING OVERNIGHT AT THE FAIRGROUNDS

There is limited space for family camping. Everyone must register - all camping spaces need to be reserved in advance and will be assigned as the reservation is received. Please contact Carol at the 4-H Office at 860-345-4511 with questions. All camping reservations are due no later than set-up, July 30.

- 1. **Overnight permission form (2016 4-H Fair overnight form)** must be completed for EACH child staying overnight at the fair. Signature of both youth and parent is required. If the parent/guardian is allowing another adult to chaperone their child, that person's signature is also required.
 - a. Only registered 4-H volunteers are allowed to serve as chaperone for someone else's child.
 - b. Make sure you indicate where 4-H member and the parent or guardian/chaperone will be sleeping. Please note that fire laws prohibit sleeping in the exhibit buildings.
 - c. Everyone staying overnight must be registered, regardless of 4-H affiliation (i.e. siblings of 4-H members who are not members themselves, younger brothers/sisters). All youth must be under the supervision of a parent/guardian or designated chaperone at ALL times.
 - d. It is important that we know who is staying over each night. Therefore, a mandatory meeting for everyone staying over (both youth and adults) is held each evening once the fair has been closed to the public and attendance is taken. Check in with the 4-H staff in charge of the evening meeting to get permission to retire early. If you have signed up to stay overnight but choose to go home, you MUST tell the 4-H staff by 6 pm that evening.
 - EVERYONE staying overnight MUST check in with the designated overnight charge person both Friday and Saturday at 10:00 pm even if they are staying in self-contained campers.
 - PLEASE NOTE: All chaperones (designated emergency contacts) must be registered 4-H volunteers if you have any questions, contact the 4-H Office.
 - Everyone staying overnight MUST attend the meeting held in the Livestock Building at the close of Fair both Friday and Saturday nights with 4-H Staff and the overnight Chaperone. Each youth/parent should check in before 6 pm on both Friday and Saturday evenings if they will not be attending that meeting (i.e. have a change of plans).

Reserving space for camper/tent – page 2 of the 2016 4-H Fair overnight form is to be completed and sent to the Middlesex County Extension Center no later than July 30 or turned in at the fair set-up. Every one staying overnight must be an enrolled 4-H member, registered volunteer or spouse.
