**Job Title:** Seasonal Resource Assistant

The Connecticut DEEP Marine Fisheries Office is currently looking for a qualified individual to fill a "Seasonal Resource Assistant" position working on GIS related projects.

This position is limited in duration and pays \$11 - \$14/hr (7hrs/day, 35hrs/wk) based on relevant experience. The selected candidate will be available to start late February or early March (contingent upon approval to re-fill) and work for approximately 6 months. Since this position is temporary, there would be no health benefits. The position is based out of DEEP Marine Headquarters in Old Lyme, CT, and employees would be expected to drive to Old Lyme each workday. Some scheduling flexibility is possible.

### Job Summary:

The position will include but is not limited to: assembling, analyzing, synthesizing and mapping diverse data sets in support of fisheries research and monitoring. The selected candidate may be asked to work on multiple projects and may be asked to create or edit maps and AGOL apps for the Agency website and ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account. The selected candidate will work under supervision, but will also be expected to work independently at times.

### Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Biology, Environmental Sciences, geography, GIS, or closely related field
- Familiarity and Experience with use of ESRI ArcMap software and ArcGIS online
- Familiarity with geodatabases
- Experience using database applications including Excel and Access
- Experience in compilation and preparation of maps, charts and graphs involving biological and environmental data
- Demonstrated ability to be organized and to work accurately paying close attention to detail
- Knowledge of fisheries or natural resource management

### Preferred Candidate Will Have:

- Knowledge of custom GIS desktop tool development and modeling
- Experience with scripting languages and de-bugging procedures
- Experience with maintaining metadata and project documentation
- Experience with geospatial and statistics analyses
- Experience creating AGOL mapping applications
