The GIS and Project Administrator also assists with the maintenance, development, and data analysis of Public Works asset management software Cityworks. The employee plays a proactive role in, ensuring that data quality and availability is maintained, produced on-time, and meets quality standards. Initiative, resourcefulness, and follow-through are expected of the employee in the normal conduct of the work.

Position requirements: The ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with Town officials, co-workers and the general public. The ability to communicate well, orally and in writing, and experience in providing oral and written presentations to different customers including the Town Council and the general public. Thorough knowledge of the standards, practices, methods, and equipment required of a state-of-the-art municipal GIS operation.
