Announcing the 2019 CT Maps Competition for Middle and High School Students

What: An online GIS map competition

Dates: February 2019 through May 2019



Who is eligible: CT public, private, or home-schooled students in middle (grades 6-8) or high school (9-12). Maps can be submitted individually or as a team of two students. Limed of one entry per student or team. Teams spanning grade levels will be entered in the division of the student at the upper grade level.

Challenge: Create an original CT based story map or web map on any topic.

ArcGIS Online requirement: Entries must use a free ArcGIS Online organizational account. Submissions must include the name of the student or team, teacher's name and school. Final map must be submitted to the CT Maps Competition website as an ArcGIS Online Presentation, ArcGIS Online Web App, or ArcGIS Online Story Map.

Dates & Deadlines:

Registration (to indicate participation) by March 22. Register online. http://s.uconn.edu/ctmapsreg Teams must submit their map to the CT Leadership Team by May 8. CT winners will be announced on May 20, 2019.

Esri will select national winners on June 3, 2019.

Prizes: Five winners in each division (middle school and high school) will be awarded \$100 prize and be entered in the national competition. Award-winning maps will be posted on the CT GIS Network website for one year.
