
The CT Maps Competition

Put your mapping skills to work in the 2020 CT Maps Competition!

- > WHAT: a free online state and national mapping competition
- > WHO: students in grades 4-12 across CT
- WHEN: students complete a web map or story map during the 2019-2020 school year using Esri's ArcGIS Online. Technical assistance is available to educators. Students and teachers submit web products to the CT Leadership Team in the spring of 2020.
- ➤ WINNERS: Up to 5 projects will be selected as cash prize winners in each category (middle school, gr. 4-8 & high school, gr. 9-12). Top winners will go on to compete with other state winners in the national competition. The overall winners in each category will earn a trip to the Esri User Conference in San Diego in July 2020.
- ➤ REGISTER: Teachers should register their schools by March 20, 2020. All web maps and story maps must be authored using a free ArcGIS Online for Organizations account, part of the ArcGIS for Schools bundle. Geomentors can provide technical assistance.
