Notice of Position:

The Town of Stonington - Department of Public Works & Engineering is seeking an individual for the "Engineering Intern\Seasonal" position. The candidate should currently be enrolled in a Civil Engineering degree program or related science curriculum. The timeline of the position is modeled for full-time (35 Hr/wk) during the summer months with the possibility of part time during the regular semester period. Estimated start date is June 1st, 2021.

Basis of Position:

Primary activities will be to assist with the development and implementation of the DEEP MS4 permit requirements within the Engineering Division. Associated tasks will include but not be limited to: Administrative review of permit requirements, tracking activities and assisting the Town's consultant with contracted tasks. Activities may include stormwater outfall reconnaissance, outfall identification, GPS location and stormwater testing. Participate in (DCIA) or Directly Connected Impervious Area tracking by means of research, review and calculation of development impervious area (reduction\dis-connect). GIS activities may include the updating of the Public Works Asset Management platform, town wide drainage system, sidewalk, signage, etc. Other MS4 activities may include field investigations for future LID (Low impact Development) implementation, preparing public outreach materials and\or preparing, reviewing regulation modifications. Other Public Works\Engineering tasks may include assisting in the review of plans, hydraulic reports for agency commissions. Participating in the review, planning and inspection of the Town's roadway paving and sidewalk replacement program.

Minimum Qualifications, Knowledge, Skills:

The candidate should be enrolled in a College\University Engineering program or closely related curriculum and have completed the Sophomore year. Other Science curriculums with an Environmental background or individuals experience in Autocad, ArcGIS, GPS, Survey, ability to read plans will be considered. The individual should have a valid driver's license, the ability to perform complex math calculations, computer skills (Microsoft Excel, Word, Power Point) and work in both an office or field environment. The hourly pay rate is \$15/Hour. Normal Hours of operation are 7:30 AM – 3:30 PM. Other hours may be arranged.
